




Cave Houses in Rojasles

Also very interesting and worth a visit are the El Rodeo caves - a series of cave dwellings built into the side of a mountain during the 19th Century. Most of the caves have now been taken over by artists and craftsmen and a regular craft market is held there. By the side of the El Rodeo caves you will find the famous 'Shell House' - a testament to the patience and perseverance of one man - Manuel Fullea Alcaraz, you can still find him working on his house, adding more shell daily. If you stand outside the house, Manuel will invite you in himself and when you have finished looking, you can purchase small mementos, decorated with shells, to remind you of your visit. There is also a small bar, selling alcoholic beverages and they have live jazz bands performing on a regular basis, you will need to enquire at the cave bar for dates etc....
