

Route 02 - Quesada to Torrevieja Marina and Beach

Leave Quesada by the Arches, go round the large roundabout and come off onto the cycle track running alongside the dual carriageway towards Torrevieja. At the third roundabout turn right towards Los Montesinos and cycle 300 metres on the road, then turn left onto the old railway line. Follow this track all the way to Torrevieja. About 1km along there is a cycle parking area and seats under a couple of trees, where the views are fantastic. You can lock your bikes here and walk to the edge of the salt lake and make snow balls with the salt. The salt water is very good for you and often you will see people floating, or washing in the water. After leaving here follow the track which changes to a paved path (the Verde Corridor) as you pass through La Siesta and San Luis follow this all the way until you come to the N332 which you cycle under, at this point you will see two newish buildings one on each side. This is the old railway station and is now a museum for the salt lakes and well worth a look. 30 metres further on you will come to a main road. Stop here and look for the masts of the boats and ships - this is the Marina/Beach area. You will have to cycle or walk through the streets, heading for the boats. There are plenty of restaurants and bars to choose from in this area, with some great Tapas Bars to satisfy your needs before retracing your tracks for the return journey.

Total Distance: Approx. 30 Kms

Time: 3 hours

Summary: Nice flat route. Plenty to see and do for all ages and abilities
